# Peachtree City Water and Sewerage Authority Minutes of Regular Meeting January 17, 2017 6:30 p.m.

The Peachtree City Water and Sewerage Authority met in a regular session Tuesday, January 17, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. in the conference room at the John W. Gronner Administrative Center.

#### GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

Mr. Hogan updated the board on the annual audit presentation, the status of the benefit and compensation study, the Rockaway plant diffuser replacement, the control panel fuse failure at Lift Station 2, and the permit violation due to excess ammonia at the Rockaway plant. He then reviewed the monthly charts including revenues and expenditures. Hogan also briefed the board regarding the flooding that occurred on private property at Tinsley Mill Condos. The recent manhole overflow occurred due to an inflow of stormwater. There was no obstruction or blockage in the line.
