Position Summary

This position ensures that wastewater treatment facilities and functions are operated and undertaken in accordance with all applicable rules, regulations, and laws.

Essential Duties

- Runs daily permit testing; performs process control analyses.
- Checks plant equipment; verifies all required equipment is operating properly.
- Collects samples.
- Maintains and cleans facilities; equipment, buildings, and grounds (including grass cutting).
- Checks and responds to SCADA; learns proper protocol for reporting alarms.
- Inspects the plant and associated equipment by sight, sound, smell, and touch.
- Reports out of parameter observations to supervisor.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

The qualifications listed below represent the credentials necessary to perform the essential functions of this position. To be successful in this position, an individual must be able to perform each duty satisfactorily. Reasonable accommodation may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- <u>Education and/or Experience</u>. High School diploma and three to five years related experience; or two years of college or Associate's Degree, and two years related experience. Must have a valid Georgia Wastewater Operator License. A minimum of a Class II Wastewater license in Georgia preferred.
- <u>Supervisory Controls</u>. Must possess ability to communicate with others. The work is performed independently. This position does not supervise any other position.

Working Conditions

- <u>Physical Demands</u>. The work requires physical exertion such as long periods of standing; walking over rough or difficult surfaces; recurring stooping, climbing, or walking; recurring lifting of objects weighing in excess of 25 pounds, and occasional lifting of objects weighing in excess of 75 pounds. The work may require specific physical abilities such as mobility and dexterity.
- <u>Work Environment</u>. The work will be in an environment involving everyday risks or discomforts which require normal safety precautions. The employee may be required to use protective clothing or equipment such as masks, coats, boots, goggles, gloves, or shield.
