**OLD AGENDA ITEMS** – 01-13-05 Southside Annexation – Developer Agreement

Mr. Hogan presented an overview of the four areas under discussion. Mr Hogan then presented the options available for consideration. A cost analysis was also reviewed from construction, risk management, operational and future revenues viewpoints.

After discussion among the Authority members, along with Q&A from guests, a motion was made by Phil Mahler, seconded by Terry Garlock, that the interest rate be equalized at 4% for both Dominion and for The Gates. The motion carried unanimously.

At the request of the WASA attorney Mark Oldenburg, a motion was then made by Phil Mahler, seconded by John Harrell that allowed for a property description to be substituted in the agreement after execution. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Phil Mahler, seconded by Terry Garlock that authorized Stephen Hogan to execute the agreement with modifications as discussed. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Phil Mahler, seconded by Terry Garlock that authorized Stephen Hogan to allocate \$350,000 from the R&E fund to establish the Meade Field Pump Station 36 Construction Account to cover the necessary funding for this project. The motion carried unanimously.

The bid tabulation for this project was shown and the lowest bidder was selected for the project. A motion was made by Phil Mahler, seconded by Terry Garlock, that the award for \$525,851 be given to Willow Construction for the Meade Field Regional Pump Station and to authorize Stephen Hogan to execute the contract. The motion carried unanimously.
