GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

Stephen Hogan updated the board on current projects including Lift Station 37, Lift Station 38, flow monitoring, and on-going manhole rehabilitation. Additional topics discussed included Aqua Aerobics filter training, the seasonal fish die-off, and the March 8th force main rupture. Hogan then reviewed the monthly charts including revenues and expenditures.

The motion was seconded by Wes Saunders and passed 4-0.
